Things to Know

- **Must have completed the downrange safety brief.**
- All users must **check out via phone or computer** on iSportsman.
- **Enter harvest data** during checkout.
- **Checkout must be completed** by the posted time each day.
- If iSportsman is **down** or you're **packing out an animal** and can't check out on time call:719-725-4682

Don't forget to sign out when you leave.

DOWNRANGE SAFETY BRIEFS

- All required safety briefs are available online via your iSportsman account.
- Access them under the "My Safety Briefs" section.
- Completion of safety briefs is mandatory before accessing downrange areas.

CHECKOUT REQUIREMENTS & PENALTIES

- All users must check out by the designated time each day through iSportsman.
- Failure to check out on time will result in:
 - A \$180 fine
 - A minimum 2-week suspension from all recreation access.

FIREARMS REGULATIONS

- All firearms (muzzleloaders, rifles, shotguns, handguns) must be registered with the Fort Carson Provost Marshal's Office.
 - Submit FC Form 66-E (Registration of Personal Firearms) to register.
 - Registration is one-time only and can include multiple weapons on a single form.

FORT CARSON REGULATIONS

- FC Reg 200-6 (Wildlife Management and Recreation)
- FC Reg 190-4 (Military Police Prohibited and Regulated Conduct)
- Regulations are available on the iSportsman website and covered in safety briefings.

IMPORTANT NOTE – FC REGULATION 190-4

- Military personnel violating paragraphs 2-2 through 2-4 (weapons transport violations) are subject to:
 - A General Officer Memorandum of Reprimand (GOMR), UCMJ action, Permanent bar from Fort Carson and PCMS, or Violation notice for 18 USC 930(a) – Possession of firearms in federal facilities
 - Civilians may also face criminal charges and/or permanent bar from Fort Carson and PCMS.
